Characteristics:	The great white shark is the largest predatory fish that feeds on many large mammals and canswim up to 35 mph!

Locations Found:	Blue sharks like to live in cooler waters and as far North as Norway and they like to swim close to the surface of the water.
Characteristics:	They give birth to live young and its main diet is based on squid and fish.
